This document specifies the conditions of use of SSA Electronic Products.

Definitions and Interpretations

SSA means Seafood Services Australia Limited (SSA), PO Box 2188, Ascot QLD 4007 AUSTRALIA, ABN 11 305 273 754, ACN 097 955 569

SSA Electronic Product means any electronic product available for purchase from the SSA Online Bookshop at <http://www.seafood.net.au/shop/> and downloaded as electronic PDF files.

Internal use means use of the Electronic Product within the Licensee's organisation.

Licence means the right to access and use the Electronic Product.

Licensee means the purchaser and user of the Electronic Product.

Licence fees means the purchase price paid by the **Licensee** when purchasing the Electronic Product via the SSA Online Bookshop.

Licence Agreement

1. By using the Electronic Product the Licensee agrees to comply with the Electronic Product Licence Conditions specified in this document.
2. The Licensee is granted a non-exclusive and non-assignable Licence to use the Electronic Product.
3. Licensees are permitted to use the Electronic Product to the following extent:
 - The Licensee may locally install and use the Electronic Product (plus one backup copy) on an individual computer.
 - The Licensee may make a maximum of three paper copies of the Electronic Product for Internal use in the Licensee's organisation.
 - The Electronic Product must not be stored, transferred or otherwise distributed on a network.
4. The Electronic Product supplied by SSA at the time of purchase is the latest version that has been approved and issued by SSA. SSA does not provide the Licensee with an updating service for the Electronic Product. The Licensee agrees that SSA has no obligation to advise you of any amendments or changes to the Electronic Product or its withdrawal from publication irrespective of the reason for any such amendment, change or withdrawal.
5. It is expressly agreed that the SSA retains all title to the intellectual property contained in the Electronic Product or is an authorized distributor of the intellectual property. Licensees shall not challenge or call into question SSA's ownership of Intellectual Property Rights in respect of the Electronic Product.
6. The electronic files and authorised paper copies of the Electronic Product, are the subject of copyright. Unauthorised copying of the Electronic Product and any modification of or merger with other software or documents is expressly forbidden. However, in consideration for entering into this Licence Agreement and agreeing to pay the Licence fees (purchase price) to SSA, the Licensee may use the Electronic Product to obtain information contained in the electronic files for their own Internal use only but shall not otherwise use, modify, copy, adapt, supply, transmit, send by email, reproduce, or do any other thing in relation to, the Electronic Product. The Electronic Product may not be copied or circulated electronically, including by electronic mail, even for Internal use.
7. The Licensee shall not modify, adapt, translate, reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble or create derivative works based on the Electronic Product.
8. The Licensee shall ensure that all of the personal users that have rights to access the Electronic Product under this Licence shall exercise that right only for the purposes specified and shall not use the Electronic Product for any other purpose.
9. For reproduction of all or portions of the Electronic Product, which are outside the circumstances included in this agreement, permission must be sought from SSA.
10. The Electronic Product is licensed only to the Licensee. Under no circumstances may the Electronic Product be transferred by the Licensee to any other party without the prior consent of SSA. Under no circumstances is the Licensee permitted to reproduce material from the Electronic Product for external use or for use on any other site or group of sites.

11. This Licence will terminate automatically and without notice if the Licensee fails to comply with any provision of the Licence. Upon termination the Licensee agrees to destroy all copies of the Electronic Product.
12. The Licensee acknowledges that no promise, representation, warranty or undertaking (other than any contained in this Agreement) has been given by SSA or any person or company on its behalf in relation to the profitability of or any other consequences or benefits to be obtained from the use of the Electronic Product and the Licensee relies wholly upon his own skill and judgment in deciding to use the Electronic Product.
13. SSA shall not be liable to the Licensee or any other person in respect of any loss or damage, however caused which may be suffered or incurred or which may arise directly or indirectly in respect to the Electronic Product.
14.
